**Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**A. Basis of Accounting**

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

**B. Inventories**

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

**C. Property and Equipment**

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

**Note 2 - Tax Status**

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

**Note 3 - Restricted Assets**

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was an increase in the balance of this reserve account to \$ 3,325.00

## REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

*To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and  
Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama*

Well Companions I can no longer report to you that Alabama is 19<sup>th</sup> in giving to the Royal Arch Research Assistance; we now rank 20<sup>th</sup>. Alabama has gone from number one in giving to 20<sup>th</sup>. We are letting Grand Chapters with less members than we have in Alabama pass us by and I suppose that it is my fault for not promoting the program as I should. I really don't know what more I can do as I report our contributions to you every year and send out a plea to all our Chapters to contribute at least \$1.00 per member so that they will be eligible to receive a 100% Certificate of Appreciation from the Royal Arch Research Assistance. The two largest Chapters in the state along with those Chapters that make no contributions at all are most responsible for our gradual slide out of the top 20. If our two largest Chapters were 100% we would add an additional \$546.00 to our contributions and if those Chapters that make no contributions at all were 100% we would add another \$634.00 to our contributions. If those Chapters that contribute less than \$1.00 per member would contribute enough to bring them up to 100% it would add another \$78.00 for a total of \$1258.00 in additional contributions.+

This past year we had five Chapters that were 100% in giving; Eunomia No.5 in Huntsville for their 15<sup>th</sup> year in a row, Mobile No.22 for their 6<sup>th</sup> year in a row, Montgomery No.21 for their 1<sup>st</sup> year, Anniston No.105 for their 14<sup>th</sup> year in a row and Monroeville No.170 for their 7<sup>th</sup> year in a row. The York Rite Ladies Craft Room continues to be the largest contributor and Mobile Chapter No.21 continues to be the largest Chapter Contributor. We are also grateful to Vulcan Council No.21, Knight Masons and the Order of High Priesthood for their support.

Those Chapters that made no contributions at all last year were: Tuscaloosa NO.1, Decatur No.38, Coosa No.86, DeKalb-Jackson No.107 and Piedmont Chapter NO.111. Two of those Chapters have Grand Officers as members.

As many of you know, as General Grand King, I serve on the Board of Directors for the Royal Arch Research Assistance but what many of you may not know is that Most Excellent Companion Larry E. Gray, General Grand High Priest, and I serve on the Board of Directors of Able Kids Foundation which receives some support from outside sources but is mainly supported through the contributions made by you and many other Royal Arch Masons to the Royal Arch Research Assistance. Last July Most Excellent Companion Gray and I attended the first ever Board of Directors meeting where I was elected Treasurer of the Foundation and we were each presented a very nice wall plaque recognizing us as Founding Members of the Foundation.

Though the contributions made to Able Kids are designated for research only you may be gratified in knowing that a total number of clients seen at the Central Auditory Diagnostic Center have exceeded 4100 for diagnosis and the clinic continues to see 6 to 12 clients per week. Most clients, but not all are children and they come from virtually every region in the country and from numerous foreign countries. There have been 43 clients from the Southeastern Region, mostly from Florida and Tennessee and there have been clients from Europe, the Far East and Latin America. So you see Companions, ours is truly an international effort, reaching out to help the hearing impaired not only in this country but those worldwide as well.

These presentations are available in VHS tapes for DVD as well and they are free of charge.

Through donations made to Royal Arch Research Assistance this past year we were able to increase our donations to Able Kids from \$200,000.00 to \$220,000.00. For those of you who contributed we thank you very much.

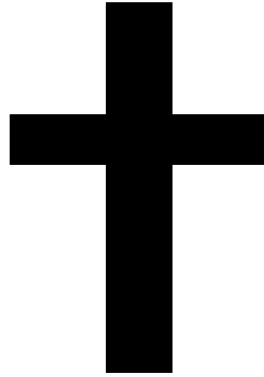

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14<sup>th</sup>, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
- G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
- H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
- I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
- J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
- K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.

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- L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
- M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
- N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
- O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
- P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
- Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
- R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
- S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
- T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
- U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
- V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
- W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
- X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
- Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
- Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
- AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.
- BB. On December 31, 2005 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. and Companion Arthur C. Harding resigned. Companion Robert C. Grigsby, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was appointed Acting Grand Secretary.
- CC. At the Annual convocation, February, 2006 Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.

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
