For the period ending December 31, 2011**

**Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**A. Basis of Accounting**

The Grand Chapter's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Under this method certain revenue and the related assets are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements do not purport to present the current financial position.

**B. Inventories**

Inventories are carried at the lower of cost determined by the First-in; first-out method of market.

**C. Property and Equipment**

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and were depreciated over the estimated useful lives of the related assets. Depreciation was computed on the straight-line method for financial reporting purposes.

**Note 2 - Tax Status**

The Grand Chapter is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501©, and from state income tax under Alabama Code Section 40-18-32. An information return is filed each year on IRS form 990.

**Note 3 - Restricted Assets**

A Triennial Reserve account is established as a reserve to cover expenses for specific officers to attend the Triennial Meeting. During the year there was no increase in the balance of this reserve account which remained at the amount of \$ 2,250.00

## REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR RESEARCH ASSISTANCE

### *To the Most Excellent Grand High Priest, Grand Officers, and Companions of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Alabama*

With the resignation of Dr. Joan Burleigh as Chief Executive Officer and Chief Researcher of Able Kids Foundation the General Grand Chapter had no other alternative but to withdraw financial support to Able Kids Foundation.

With the resignation of Dr. Burleigh, Able Kids Foundation was left without a researcher and due to the fact that all contributions made through Royal Arch Research Assistance have always been designated for research it became necessary for Royal Arch Research Assistance to sever relations with Able Kids. Royal Arch Research had many good years and a warm relationship with Able Kids and all of their wonderful staff and it was very difficult for the Board of Royal Arch Research to sever such a successful partnership. Able Kids has been the only foundation or institution doing research in Central Auditory Processing Deficit to develop a simple and inexpensive device (an ear filter) to assist those with CAPD. As Able Kids continue to evaluate and fit those with CAPD I strongly encourage you to continue to recommend those persons to Able Kids that you may know with this disabling condition.

With the Separation of Able kids and Royal Arch Research the difficult task of finding other researchers in CAPD became a monumental task for the Board and it took several months of searching, study and interviewing potential foundations and institutions before a decision was made as where you contributions would be expended in the future. The first decision made by the Board was that contributions would be made in the form of grants. The next decision made was that the grants would be given from year to year. Finally a decision was made as to whom the grants would be given which resulted in the following: \$100,000.00 to Autism Speaks, \$100,000.00 to Hearing Health Foundations and \$60,000.00 to Auditory Research Department of the University of Connecticut. There are new brochures available at this meeting describing these wonderful organizations and the work they do. Please take enough of these to distribute to your membership.

I will report to you the contributions made to Royal Arch Research Assistance by this Grand Chapter Las year was \$3,229.00. There were eight Chapters that received 100% certificates: Eunomia #5, Montgomery #22, Dothan #113, Cyrus #6, Phenix City #149, Mobile #21, Anniston #105 and Fort Payne #107. Unfortunately there were five Chapters that made no donations at all. Alabama still remains number 18 in total giving.

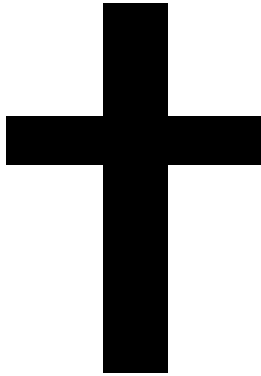

- A. May, 1823: A Small group met in Mobile, for the purpose of forming the Grand Royal Arch Chapter in Alabama, and Grand Officers were appointed.
- B. January, 1824: Regular annual convocation, and at the same time henceforward until otherwise noted.
- C. June: There being no convocation in January, the Grand Chapter being declared irregular by the General Grand Chapter, it was therefore reorganized in June, 1827 and a new constitution adopted.
- D. December: At this time annual convocations were changed to July.
- E. July: In accordance with previous order, and at same time henceforward until otherwise noted.

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- F. No election, the Grand Chapter having "adjourned" on the evening of July 14<sup>th</sup>, until the next evening, but it did not convene again, the members having dispersed.
  - G. There had been no convocation of the Grand Chapter for upwards of seven years, in consequence, perhaps, of the Morgan excitement. In December, 1837, a few companions assembled in Tuscaloosa and re-organized by the adoption of a constitution and the election of Grand Officers. The constitution of 1837 was adopted, and the annual convocation fixed for December.
  - H. In 1925 the office of Deputy Grand High Priest was abolished.
  - I. At the Annual Convocation in December, 1944, the time of meeting was changed to the Third Monday in November.
  - J. At Annual Convocation in 1946, on account of ill health, companion John Wilson Terry was made Grand Treasurer Emeritus, and companion Frank Albert Gillette was elected Grand Treasurer.
  - K. On August 4, 1947, following the death of companion Guy T. Smith, companion W. E. Glazner was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
  - L. At the Annual Convocation, November, 1947, Companion Charles W. Stubinger was elected Grand Secretary.
  - M. At the Annual Convocation of the Grand Chapter R.A.M. of Alabama held on February 14, 1956, Companion Charles H. Stubinger was elected M.E. Grand High Priest, to serve in this capacity during the election of officers.
  - N. On June 27, 1960, following the sudden death of Companion Charles H. Stubinger, Companion Thomas L. Cochran was appointed acting Grand Secretary.
  - O. On September 16, 1960 following the resignation of Companion Thomas L. Cochran, Companion Gordon L. Evatt was appointed Grand Secretary.
  - P. On December 1, 1960, Companion Varna A. Rushton was appointed Grand Secretary to succeed Companion Gordon L. Evatt, who had resigned.
  - Q. Grand York Rite office moved from Montgomery to Birmingham after election of Thomas W. Oliver as Grand Secretary.
  - R. At Annual Convocation, February, 1973, Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary. Thomas W. Oliver was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus.
  - S. Annual Convocation date changed to last Monday in February.
  - T. As proof of continued effort of Alabama to promote York Rite Unity, the first combined meeting of the Grand Chapter, Grand Council and Grand Commandery was held in February 1974.
  - U. On November 1, 1974, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 3621 South 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Birmingham, Alabama 35222.
  - V. On October 1, 1979, the Grand York Rite office was moved to a new location at 5504 ½ North 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama 35212.
  - W. On May 16, 1980, James A. Kile was appointed Grand Treasurer to succeed Hoyt McClendon who resigned.
  - X. At Annual Convocation, February, 1981, Hoyt McClendon was elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus.
  - Y. On September 1, 1991, Companion Thomas W. Mann and Companion James A. Kile resigned and Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. appointed as Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding appointed as Grand Secretary.
  - Z. At the Annual Convocation in February, 1992 Companion Thomas W. Mann was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Past Grand High Priest (Honorary). Companion James A. Kile was Elected Grand Treasurer Emeritus. Companion Fred W. McCluskey, Jr. was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Arthur C. Harding was elected Grand Secretary.
  - AA. At the Annual Convocation, February, 2003 Jesse W. Locke was elected Grand High Priest Honorary by a unanimous vote.

Harding was elected Grand Secretary Emeritus and Grand High Priest Honorary. Companion Joe D. Lee was elected Grand Treasurer and Companion Hiram O. Williams, Jr. was elected Grand Secretary.

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
